

SMOKING SAFETY TIPS

- Never smoke when oxygen is flowing.
- Do not smoke when you are tired.
- If you are shaky, use a fire proof smoking apron to avoid burns.
- Extinguish your cigarette in ashtrays only.
- Ask for help from the staff if you need it.

STOPPING SMOKING

If your are interested in trying to stop smoking, please talk to your nurse, who will consult with your physician on strategies for quitting or cutting back.

SMOKING SAFETY

For the health and safety of residents, staff, families, and volunteers, smoking is only permitted in designated areas outside of the facility.



No smoking in your room.



No smoking in hallways.



No smoking on the patios or decks.



No smoking near flowing oxygen.

SMOKING VIOLATIONS

Smoking restrictions will be imposed if any resident is observed smoking in any area other than the designated smoking areas.

IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE TO SMOKE

- Staff may volunteer their time to assist you, but it is not a requirement of their jobs.
- There may be times when no staff are available to assist you.
- Every effort will be made to ensure that adaptive devices such as smoking aprons are available for you if you need to ensure your safety.
